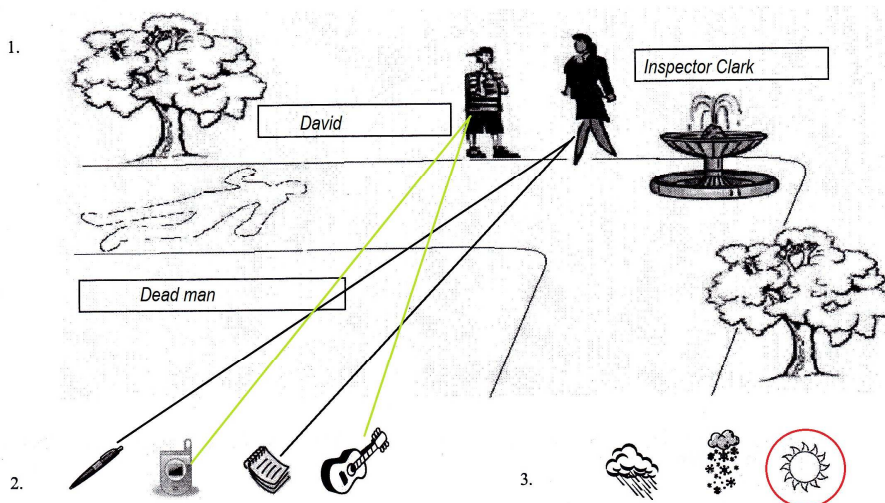

WRONG l.15 "he knew that he mustn't move the body."

5. The man had died a long time ago.

WRONG l.16 "it was warm"

6. It was Inspector Clark's first investigation in London.

WRONG l.20 "during her fifteen year's service with the London police".
